

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Affirmative	Negative
I am (I'm) singing.	I am not (I'm not) singing.
You are (You're) dancing.	You are not (You aren't) dancing.
She is (She's)playing.	She is not (She isn't)playing.
He is (He's) coming.	He is not (He isn't) coming.
It is (It's) running.	It is not (It isn't) running.
We are (We're) sleeping.	We are not (We aren't) sleeping.
You are (You're) sitting.	You are not (You aren't) sitting.
They are (They're) lying.	They are not (They aren't) lying
