Present Perfect with *Already, Yet, Just*

You can use the present perfect to talk about events that happened *before now*.
It is possible that the event happened earlier than expected.

Questions	Affirmative	Negative
Have you done the dishes yet ?	Yes, I've already done them	No, I haven't done them yet .
Have you already washed the clothes?	Yes, I've just washed them	No, I haven't washed them yet

Brief Explanation

choose the answer:

- 1- Have you done the dishes (already – just – yet)?
- 2- I have (already – ever – yet) done them.
- 3- I haven't finished my homework (yet - already - ever).
- 4- Have you (ever - never - yet) painted the room.

Application

- 5- Have you (do - did - done) the dishes yet?
- 6- Have you already (wash - washing -washed) the clothes?
- 7- Has she (build - builds - built) the house?
- 8- They (has - hasn't - haven't) read the new story yet.
