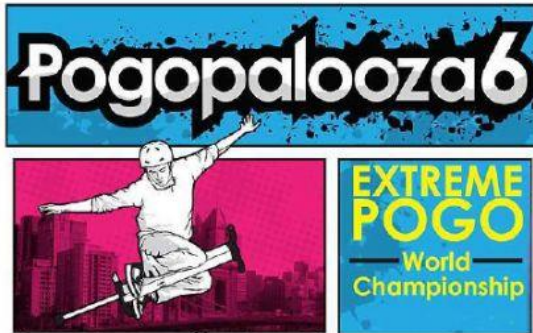

It's pogo but not as you know it!

My editor asked me to go to Pittsburgh and cover the Pogopalooza, the annual pogo championships. **1** While I was traveling, I couldn't help thinking about my first pogo stick and how much fun it was jumping up the street with my friends! However, I wasn't really prepared for what I was about to see.

As soon as I arrived at Pogopalooza, I was **blown away**! I saw someone jump over a car on a pogo stick, then another pogoer did a backflip. My mouth fell open **2** ... It was an extreme sport! There was a crowd around a pogoer who was just jumping up and down. "Anyone can do that" I thought. Then I noticed an electronic board showing his jumps, 104.454 and counting. He wasn't even tired. He was trying to break the record for the most jumps, and he was **halfway** there. Later in the day, there was a pogo high jump **contest**, where pogoers were jumping over 2 meters. An event

organizer informed me that the world record was 2,92 meters **3** I had to learn more.

Luckily, one of the pioneers of Xpogo, Dave Armstrong, was at this year's event and he gave me information about the evolution of the pogo stick. With the original stick you could jump as high as 15 or 20cm. Armstrong explained that that he had re invented the pogo stick by using elastic bands. With the new pogo stick, you can reach heights of 2 meters.

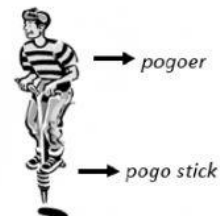
4 The latest models use air pressure to propel the jumper and they are setting new world records all the time.
