8. If my grandmother had gone to the university, she (study) science. She likes science a lot.
9. If I had known how to swim, I (swim) when we went to the beach.
10. If you had given a direct address to me, I (find) that museum easily.
11. If I had had enough money, I (buy) a big house for myself.
12. We (go) for the picnic yesterday if the weather had not been rainy.

If you (ask) me, I (help) you.
If we (go) to the cinema, we (see) my friend Jacob.
If you (speak) English, she (understand)
If they (listen) to me, we (be) home earlier.
I (write) you a postcard if I (have) your address.
If I (not/break) my leg, I (take part) in the contest.
If it (not/ start) to rain, we (walk) to the museum.
We (swim) in the sea if there (not / be) so many sharks there.
If she (take) the bus, she (not / arrive) on time.
