1 syllable adjective:

Adjective + er + THAN: Peter is shorter than Paul.

2 or more syllable adjective:

More + adjective + THAN: Paul is more intelligent than Peter.

Types of adjectives:

Finished in Y	One syllable:	Two or more syllables
Happy > happier	Tall > taller	Expensive > more expensive

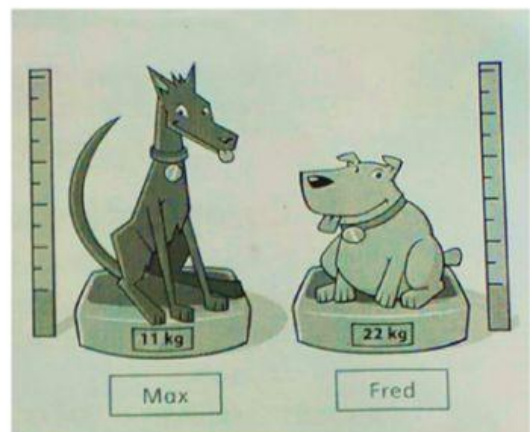
