- \_\_\_\_\_ A theatrical production incorporating both vocal and instrumental music, drama, and sometimes dance; considered the most collaborative art form.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The highest female vocal range.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A song for two voices.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The lowest female vocal range.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The Italian word meaning "little book."
- \_\_\_\_\_ The middle male vocal range.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The individual who has the artistic view for how the opera will be performed.
- \_\_\_\_\_ They play the music.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The highest male voice.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A piece of music written for a group of singers.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The person who writes the music for an opera.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The musical introduction to an opera.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A lighthearted opera with some talking, similar to a musical.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A group of singers, from all voice types, that support the principal cast.
