Focus on "the performer" of the action.	Focus on "the receiver (DO)" of the action. BE + V _{past} participle



ACTIVE VOICE:

Mario Vargas Llosa **wrote** *La Fiesta del chivo* in 2000.

PASSIVE VOICE:

La Fiesta del chivo **was written** by Mario Vargas Llosa in 2000.

Focus on the subject:
Vargas Llosa is the **performer**

Focus on the object:
La fiesta del chivo is the **receiver (DO)**

1) SIMPLE PRESENT	: IS/ ARE + V _{past} participle
2) SIMPLE PAST	: WAS/ WERE + V _{past} participle
3) PRESENT CONTINUOUS	: IS/ARE BEING + V _{past} participle
4) PAST CONTINUOUS	: WAS/ WERE BEING + V _{past} participle
5) PRESENT PERFECT	: HAS/HAVE BEEN + V _{past} participle
6) FUTURE	: WILL + BE + V _{past} participle
