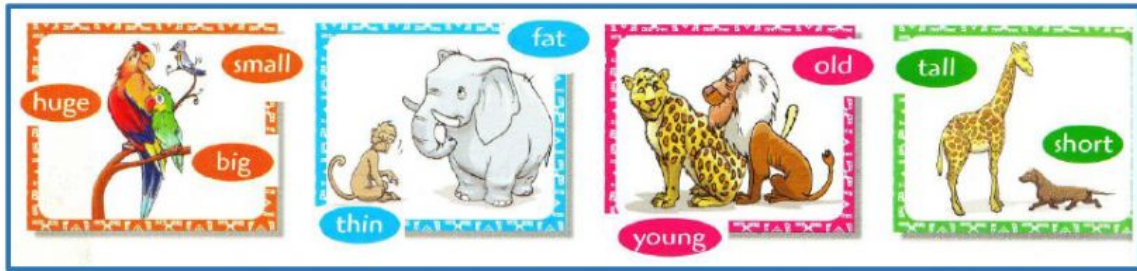

He – His Example: His hair is short.

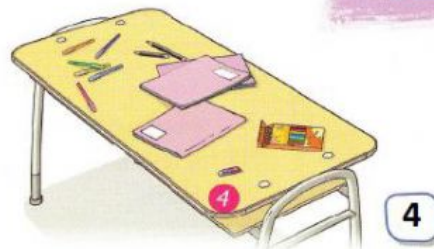
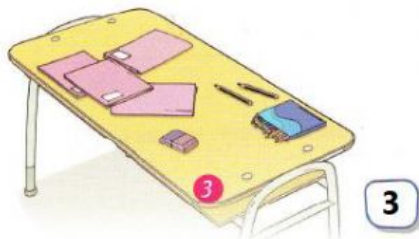
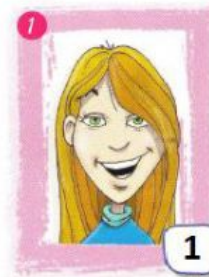


She – Her Example: Her hair is long.

And - But

We use AND to add information.

Example: My hair is long **and** brown.

We use BUT to show contrast.

Example: I have a board game **but** I don't have a robot.
