### Form

Did + I, we, they, you, he, she, it + Verb Infinitive

### Examples:

1. Did you watch television?

Yes, I did.

Or






No, I didn't

### Form

Wh.

Verb  
Infinitive

If the main verb is  
verb to be:

was/  
were

+
