

Apuntes: regular verbs ending in 'ar, er, or ir'

Ejemplos (examples)

Caminar (is the infinitive form of the verb) means to walk

When conjugating it (changing it) you remove the (infinitive) ar ending (keep the root/stem) and replace with the ending from the chart depending on the pronoun. If the pronoun is (Yo) it becomes Yo camino

Comer (is the infinitive form of the verb) means to eat

When conjugating it (changing it) you remove the (infinitive) er ending (keep the root/stem) and replace with the ending from the chart depending on the pronoun. If the pronoun is (Ella/él/usted(Ud.)) it becomes Ella/él/usted(Ud.) come

Escribir (is the infinitive form of the verb) means to write

When conjugating it (changing it) you remove the (infinitive) ir ending (keep the root/stem) and replace with the ending from the chart depending on the pronoun. If the pronoun is (nosotros/as) it becomes nosotros/as escribimos
