Rule #4 *The following words and expressions are singular and must be followed by a singular verb:*

<i>each</i>	<i>each of</i>	<i>every</i>	<i>everyone of</i>
<i>one of</i>	<i>not one of</i>	<i>neither of</i>	<i>anyone</i>
<i>anyone of</i>	<i>someone</i>	<i>somebody</i>	<i>everyone</i>
<i>anybody</i>	<i>nobody</i>	<i>none of</i>

Each of the boys (wants, want) a turn.

Somebody in the room (has, have) a loud voice.

Someone in this class (is, are) going with me.
