## Stative Verbs

Some verbs rarely appear in the continuous tenses. These verbs express a permanent state and they are: appear (= seem), be, believe, belong, cost, feel, forget, hate, have (= possess), know, like, love, mean, need, prefer, realise, remember, see, seem, smell, sound, suppose, taste, think, understand, want, etc.

I understand it now. NOT I am understanding it now.

Some of these verbs can be used in continuous tenses but with a difference in meaning.

## **Present Simple**

I think he's Italian.

(= believe)

Katie looks happy.

(= appears to be)

You can see the sea from my room.

(= it is visible)

Derek has a new car.

(= possesses)

This pie tastes really good.

(= it has a really good flavour)

This new dress fits her perfectly.

(= it is her size)

He is so polite.

(= that's his character)

She appears to be tired.

(= seems)

## **Present Continuous**

Tom is thinking of moving house.

(= is considering)

They are looking at the paintings.

(= are taking a look at)

Sam is seeing his friends tonight.

(= is meeting)

We are having dinner at 8 o'clock.

(= are eating)

Paul is tasting the soup to see if it needs salt.

(= is trying)

He is fitting a new lock on the door.

(= is attaching)

He is being so rude today!

(= he is behaving like that only today)

She is appearing in a new TV show.

(= is taking part)
