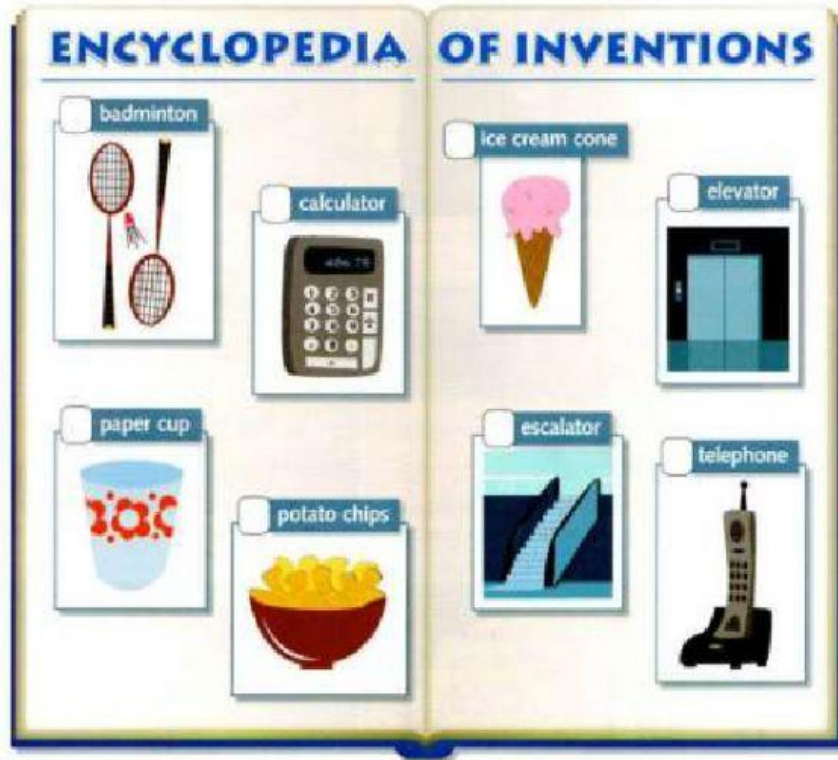

During the 1950s, explorers on the island of Sulawesi in Indonesia discovered a series of cave paintings. At the time, experts assumed that they were less than 10,000 years old, making them 'young' in terms of cave art. Some European examples of cave art date back almost 38,000 years, and it is these earliest paintings that excite researchers the most. However, dating techniques in the 1950s were not as advanced as they are today. Using a new technique he developed, scientist and archaeologist Maxime Aubert re-examined the Sulawesi cave art and discovered that their origins are much older than first believed. His findings suggest that the paintings were created up to 40,000 years ago. This means that they could be older than any known European cave paintings, and might possibly be the oldest known 'artwork' on the planet.
