

Their pets are usually Siberian dogs.

 Eskimos spend a lot of time in their houses, called igloos. They don't go out much because it is very cold. Sometimes it snows for weeks, and they prefer to stay inside. They usually watch Netflix series, play on-line games, or just eat and sleep! They usually wear fur clothes and fur shoes. They never wear t-shirts or shorts! They wear fur hoodies, too, because they protect the head from the cold wind.

Euen, an eskimo boy, lives in a small town in the north of Alaska. He is mad about animals, especially dogs and he is really interested in nature in general. He has got 3 Siberian dogs. Now he is in his last year at secondary school, but when he finishes, he wants to go to university to become a vet.
