The weather was worse this year. Charlie's school had to close and his parents couldn't go shopping or go to work. It was too dangerous to drive their small car.



I'd like to make some pancakes but we haven't got any milk or eggs!' Mum said on Monday morning.


'We need toothpaste, too,' Dad said.
