


# Adverbs and Adjectives

Hint: most adverbs end with -ly

An **adjective** tells more about a noun.

The elephant. ....

The **big** elephant .....



An **adverb** tells more about a verb.

This adverb tells us *how* the elephant walked.

....walked

....walked **slowly**.

Some **adjectives** can become **adverbs** by adding -ly

| The     | big       | elephant | walked    | slowly.   |
| The     | colourful | parrot   | screeched | loudly.   |
| The     | slimy     | snail    | moved     | slowly.   |
| The     | chubby    | baby     | laughed   | happily.  |
| The     | drunk     | man      | acted     | stupidly. |
| The     | little    | dog      | yapped    | noisily.  |
| The     | big       | dog      | barked    | fiercely. |
| The     | tired     | man      | yawned    | sleepily. |
| The     | busy      | woman    | worked    | quickly.  |
| The     | cranky    | boy      | stamped   | angrily.  |

Some are the same

Adjective      Adverb

fast      fast

Some are different

good      well

Some change meaning

poor      poorly
