


So you're asked to submit a CV for a job application

Maybe you're 1 \_\_\_\_\_ "What is a CV "? and "How is it different from a resume "?

Let us help you with a quick 2 \_\_\_\_\_ of Résumé versus CV.

Typically, the key 3 \_\_\_\_\_ between a Resume and a CV is that a resume is a concise 4 \_\_\_\_\_ of one's experience in a variety of 5 \_\_\_\_\_, while a CV emphasizes on more detailed account of one's 6 \_\_\_\_\_ related experiences

Also, an entry -level resume 7 \_\_\_\_\_ to be one page, while a CV is usually multiple 8 \_\_\_\_\_.

In some 13 \_\_\_\_\_ the term CV is used synonymously with "resume ". 14\_\_\_\_\_, in the US this tends to be very different 15 \_\_\_\_\_. Here is how: the CV goes to extra mile to 16\_\_\_\_\_ not just work experience and 17\_\_\_\_\_ but also awards, honors, publications, 18\_\_\_\_\_ presentations, achievements, affiliations, skills and more.

These extra categories highlight skills most 19\_\_\_\_\_ academic settings which is why the CV is most 20\_\_\_\_\_ for graduate school applications. It's also used by people with or 21\_\_\_\_\_ advanced to greater, such as graduate students and postdoctoral 22\_\_\_\_\_.
