STRUCTURE:

HAVE
HAS

+ PAST PARTICIPLE

We use the present perfect for:

1- **Unfinished actions** (= It starts in the past and is still happening in the present).

e.g. She **has lived** in Ireland since 2008.

She moved to Ireland

She lives in Ireland now

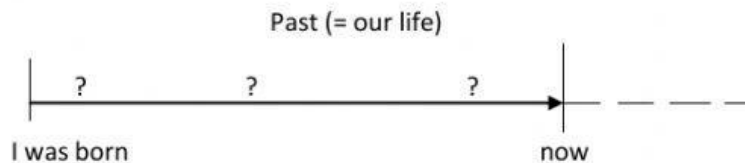
