Ví dụ	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You should drink some water. (Bạn nên uống một chút nước.)• Should I take off my shoes? (Tôi có nên cởi giày không?)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can I help you? (Tôi có thể giúp bạn không?)
Ví dụ	<p><i>Permission</i> (Sự cho phép)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can I use the phone? (Tôi có thể sử dụng điện thoại không?)• Could I use the phone, please? (Tôi có thể sử dụng điện thoại không?)	<p><i>Requests</i> (Yêu cầu)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you pass the salt? (Bạn có thể đưa tôi muối không?)• May I have the salt, please? (Bạn có thể đưa tôi muối không?)

* Note: - V(inf) = Infinitive: Động từ nguyên mẫu

- **COULD** và **MAY** có tính trạng trọng hơn so với **CAN**.






