SIMPLE FUTURE	BE GOING TO	PRESENT PERFECT
(+) S + will/ shall + V-inf. (-) S + will/ shall + not + V-inf. (?) Will / Shall + S + V-inf? → Yes, S + will/shall. → No, S + will/shall + not.	(+) S + am/is/are + going to + V-inf. (-) S + am/is/are + not going to + V-inf. (?) Am/Is/Are + S + going to + V-inf? → Yes, S + am/is/are. → No, S + am/is/are + not.	(+) S + have/has + PII. (-) S + haven’t/hasn’t + PII. (?) Have/Has + S + PII? → Yes, S + have/has. → No, S + have/has + not.

\* Note: PII = Quá khứ phân từ II; (+) = Khẳng định; (-) = Phủ định; (?) = Nghi vấn
