Cast: Narrator(s) - Monkey - Snake - Elephant - Sharp-Shooter (human) - Wild Dog (human)

Narrator: Deep in the jungle there was a party going on. There was Monkey (*Enters Monkey*), Snake (*Enters Snake*) and Elephant (*Enters Elephant*)

Monkey: Let's boogie!

Elephant: Dance! Dance!

Snake: I can't, I've got no legs! You guys are silly! Sit down and read a book.

Monkey: Snake you are so boring!

Snake: Turn that music down.

Monkey: Okay (*Turns music down*)

Elephant: That's not fair.

Snake: Remember that there could be hunters in the jungle.

Narrator: Even though the others thought that Snake was being boring, he was right. On the other side of the jungle were some people looking to catch animals.

(*Enter Sharp-shooter and Wild Dog*)

Sharp-shooter: Wow! This jungle is amazing! We are so close to nature.

Wild Dog: When can I eat?

Sharp-shooter: We will go in search of some monkey for you to eat soon.

Wild Dog: Monkey! My favourite!

Narrator: If the animals were on the menu then Monkey, Snake and Elephant were in trouble.

Monkey: Who wants a banana?

Elephant: I'm an elephant. Why would I want a banana?!

Snake: Mice for me.

Monkey: OK I will go and look for some food for everyone.

Narrator: So Monkey set off to find food for him and his friends not knowing what he would find.

Sharp-shooter: If we do not start to put up our tent soon then it will be too dark to see what we are doing.

Wild Dog: I don't want to sleep, I want to eat!

Sharp-shooter: Relax, we are putting up our tent and we'll get your monkey. You need to be patient.

Wild Dog: I'm too hungry to be patient.

Narrator: As Monkey got closer and closer to the human's camp, he didn't know what would happen.

Wild Dog: I can smell something.

Sharp-shooter: What is it?

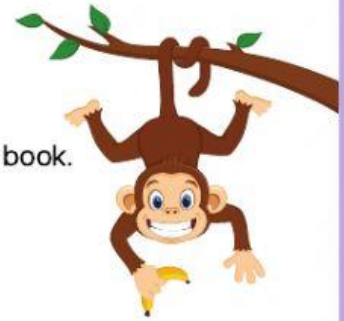
Wild Dog: Monkey!
