
Table	Shows what something looks like (taken with a camera)

The Skeletal System

The skeletal system is made up of all the bones in your body. It is also made of the things that connect your bones together: tendons, ligaments, and cartilage. The skeletal system also includes one set of hard objects that aren't bones: your teeth!

Ear - the front of the eye that sees from the nose to the ears
Ear - the outer layer of tissue that covers the entire ear
Ear - the large structure of bones in the head

Central Nervous System

Brain - the part of the body that controls all functions in the body. It includes things like thinking, feeling, learning, and remembering. It is made up of billions of tiny cells that work together to control the body.

Spinal Cord - the long pathway that connects the brain with the peripheral nervous system. It is protected by a hard outer coating, which is a long series of bones called vertebrae.
