**were playing** **was starting**  
**was playing** **were starting**

3- When Bob **was having** his car accident, he **looked** at his mobile phone.  
**had** **were looking**  
**were having** **was looking**

4- Emma **skied** when she **was breaking** her leg.  
**were skiing** **broke**  
**was skiing** **were breaking**

5- When I last **saw** Bob's children, they **was playing** in their garden.  
**was seeing** **were playing**  
**were seeing** **played**

6- Mr Johnson **swam** in the ocean when a shark **was attacking** him.  
**was swimming** **attacked**  
**were swimming** **were attacking**

7- My mobile phone **was ringing** while I **was having** a bath.  
**rang** **had**  
**were ringing** **were having**

8- They **were crossing** the street when the lights **was turning** red.  
**was crossing** **were turning**  
**crossed** **turned**

9- When my mother **came** in the room, my father **jumped** on his bed.  
**was coming** **was jumping**  
**were coming** **were jumping**

10-I **was meeting** my teacher in the street while I **did** shopping.  
**were meeting** **were doing**  
**met** **was doing**
