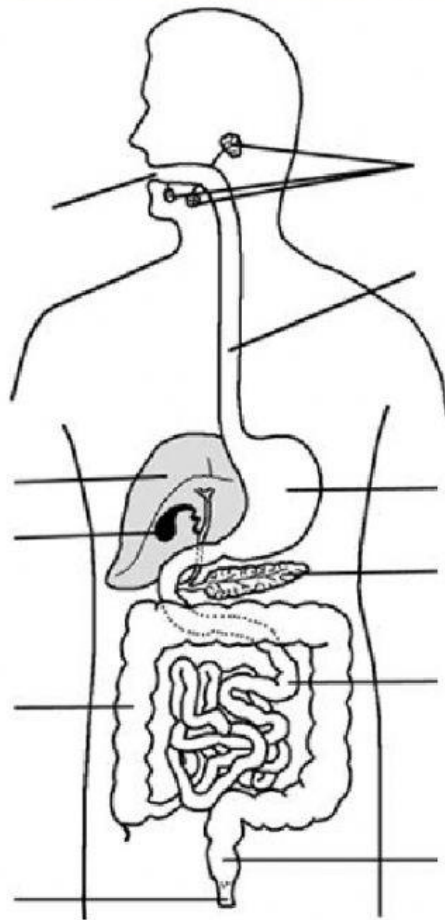


DIAGRAM SHOWING THE HUMAN
