Introduction

Present and contextualise your topic / say what others think about it:
Technology is very important in the modern world. Students need technology to investigate about different topics for English, Science, Chemistry, etc. So,

Ask a rhetorical question in one complex sentence: **has technology a vital role to play in education?**

I believe technology has it

Sentence starters to introduce a topic: Nowadays it is said that; Many people believe that; It is widely known that; What is more important...?; How do we guarantee that...?

Body – Paragraph 1

Present your opinion: The first reason why I believe that technology has a vital role to play in education is because

Give a reason: it is easier to investigate a topic using technology,

Give an example to exemplify your opinion: for example the internet, where you can find information in sites LIKE wikipedia, AMONG others.

Sentence starters to present an opinion: In my opinion; I personally defend that... for the reason that; I believe that; In my view... these are the reasons why

Body – Paragraph 2

Present your opinion: In addition, thanks TO technology students continued THEIR education DURING the COVID-19 pandemic

Give a reason: because students couldn't go to school because it was PROHIBITED

Give an example to exemplify your opinion: for example, if students went to school they could get infected with the virus

Sentence starters to add an argument: In addition; Furthermore; Moreover; The reason I say this is that; Another point to consider is the fact that; It is common / general knowledge that; As... defends,

Conclusion

Summarise your main argument or repeat it in different words: In conclusion, technology has a vital role in education people need IT to investigate EASILY and to study during a sanitary emergency

End with a quote, a rhetorical question or a recommendation:
for these reason is important that all schools in the world have access to technology


Sentence starters to conclude: To summarise; To sum up; In short; In conclusion; For all the above reasons I defend that; All things considered; To conclude
