NORTH CAROLINA :

2. “ The officer shall not bury any colored person on a ground used for the burial of white people”.

3. “ It shall be unlawful for colored people to frequent parks which are used for the enjoyment of white people”.

4. “ It shall be illegal to conduct a restaurant in which white and black people are served ”.

5. “ The schools for white and Negro children shall be conducted separately ”.
