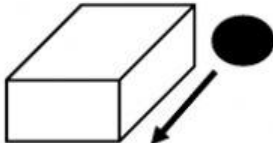


Grammar Note :

- They walk **along** the path together to the island.
- She showed the peach to her husband and placed it **against** the wall.



- The words **along** and **against** are Prepositions of Position.
- They show the location of an object or person.

Preposition	Explanation	Example
Along 	• We use 'along' for things that are placed from one end to the other.	 The trees are planted along the road.
	• We also use 'along' when someone or something is moving in a constant direction.	 The tourist enjoy walking along the beach.
Against 	• We also use 'against' when someone or something is pressing on another object.	 The man is leaning against the wall.
	• We also use 'against' to talk about the physical contact made by two objects.	 The waves are crashing against the rocks.
