

NEGATION (NOT) - verbs that need to do

Complete the verb to do

Present simple	Past simple
I	I
you	you
he/she/it	he/she/it
we	we
they	they

Make the following sentences NEGATIVE.

- Find the verb
- Is it present or past?
- Use the helper (auxiliary) verb *to do*.

Example 1: He likes swimming.

➤ verb: likes ➤ present ➤ he does ➤ he does not ➤ like

Example 2: He played football.

➤ verb: played ➤ past ➤ he did ➤ he did not ➤ play

They **play** volleyball.

3. We watched the football.

We the football.

4. He likes tennis.

He tennis.

5. She went fishing.

She fishing.

6. She goes camping.

She camping.
