**LEARN THIS!** Compound nouns: noun + noun

- a Most compound nouns are formed from two nouns.
- b We usually write them as two words (*travel agent*), but sometimes as one word (*whiteboard*) or with a hyphen (*film-maker*). Check in a dictionary.
- c The stress is usually on the first noun: *whiteboard*
