a building where rare, valuable and interesting things are kept and shown to the public

**mush** *noun*

a thick, soft mass of food

**Similar Meaning:** mash, pulp

**mushroom** *noun*

**1** a fungus that grows in damp places and is the shape of a small, flat umbrella. Many types of mushrooms can be eaten.

**mushroom** *verb*

**2** to appear and grow up quickly

**music** *noun*

**1** a combination of sounds played on musical instruments or sung to make tunes or sound patterns **2** printed notes and signs that stand for sounds and can be played on a musical instrument or sung

**musician** *(say mew-zish-un) noun*

someone trained in music, especially someone whose job is to play a musical instrument

**Muslim** *(say muz-lim) noun*

a follower of Islam, the religion based on the teachings of Mohammed

**mutiny****mussel** *noun*

a type of shellfish with a blackshell made of two parts that fit tightly together and a soft body that can be eaten

**Homophones:** mussel sounds like muscle

**mustard** *noun*

a hot-tasting yellow powder or paste made from the seeds of a herb and used as a spice in cooking

**musty** *adjective*

smelling stale and damp

**mute** *noun*

**1** someone who cannot speak or make sounds **2** something that can be put on a musical instrument to soften the sound

**mute** *adjective*

**3** silent, not speaking or unable to speak

**mutiny** *(say mew-ti-nee) noun*

**1** a rebellion by soldiers or sailors against their officers
