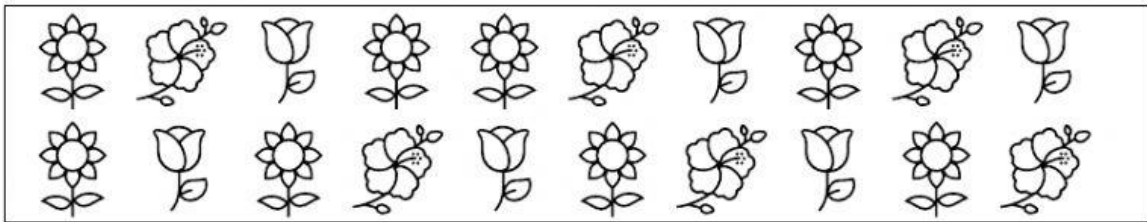
Learning Activity Goals : Students can understand why data must be presented in a certain form

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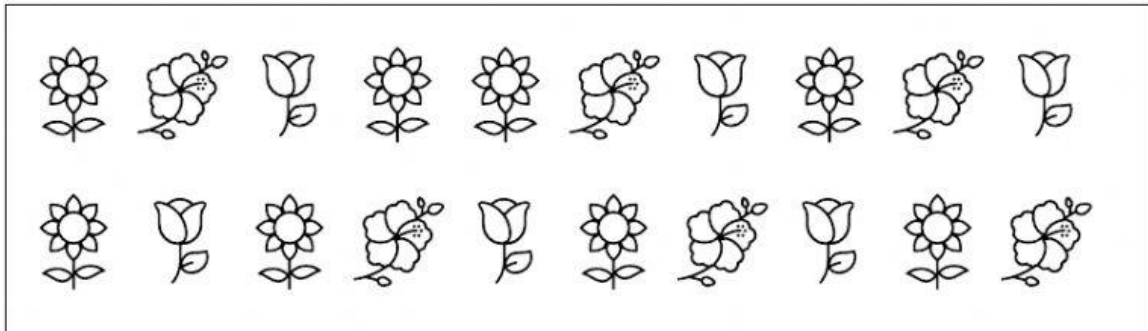
