EXPRESSING QUANTITY - AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES

We use "there is/there are" to refer to the existence or presence of someone or something:

There's a letter for Julia.

There are several people in line.

We use 'there is' for singular:

There is



There's only one necklace.

We use 'there are' for plural:

There are



There are two necklaces
