PRESENT SIMPLE - USES

- Do every day/week/year
- Generally true
- Always happen

PRESENT CONTINUOUS - USES

- I am working → now
- I am working → around now
- In this picture → describing a picture

PRESENT PERFECT - USES

- Action that started in the past and has a link to the present → I've cleaned the car - it looks new!
- There is no exact time in which it occurred:
 - ✓ yet → Have you seen it yet? Ya/todavía ?/N
 - ✓ just → I have just heard it Acabo de +
 - ✓ already → Mary has already baked it Ya +

PAST SIMPLE - USES

- I went there last summer → Finished actions, that happened once or + in the past

PAST CONTINUOUS - USES

- I was playing from seven to eight → To describe an action in progress at a specific moment in the past
- In 1960 I was living in Madrid → To describe a situation at the beginning of a story

BE GOING TO (around future)

- ✓ Predictions with evidence
- Look at the clouds, it's going to rain

- ✓ Intentions:
- I'm going to lose weight
- ✓ Plans without concrete details
- We are going to learn French next semester

WILL / WON'T (PREDICTIONS) - USES

- I will/won't be late → For future predictions (think, guess...)
- I think she'll pass the exam → I think/I don't think/I'm sure + will
I think she won't pass

WILL/WON'T/SHALL (OTHER USES) for instant:

DECISIONS	OFFERS	PROMISES
I'll go home late	I'll help you	I'll always love you
	Shall I/we open the door? (offers (?))
