Remember that we use the Past Simple tense to talk about things that happened and finished in the past. We must use regular and irregular verbs.

REGULAR VERBS		
I	studied	English
We	enjoyed	the party
He	travelled	to Mexico

IRREGULAR VERBS		
You	bought	an apple
She	read	a book
They	wrote	a letter
