Most historians consider French inventor Nicolas-Joseph Cugnot's steam-powered tractor to be the first vehicle like an automobile. That came about in 1769, and was followed about 60 years later by an electric carriage. The gasoline-powered vehicles we are most familiar with came next, with the construction of the first gas-powered engine in 1867.
