  - It seems unlikely that I'll get the job.
  - 2. I'll definitely get the job.
  - 3. I probably won't get the job.

- There's no way that Ken will arrive by noon.
  - A. Ken may not arrive by noon.
  - B. Ken probably won't arrive by noon.
  - C. There's no chance Ken will arrive by
  - B. Maybe Ana will pass the course.
    - It's possible Ana will pass the course.
    - B. Ana will definitely pass the course.
    - It seems unlikely Ana will pass the course.
