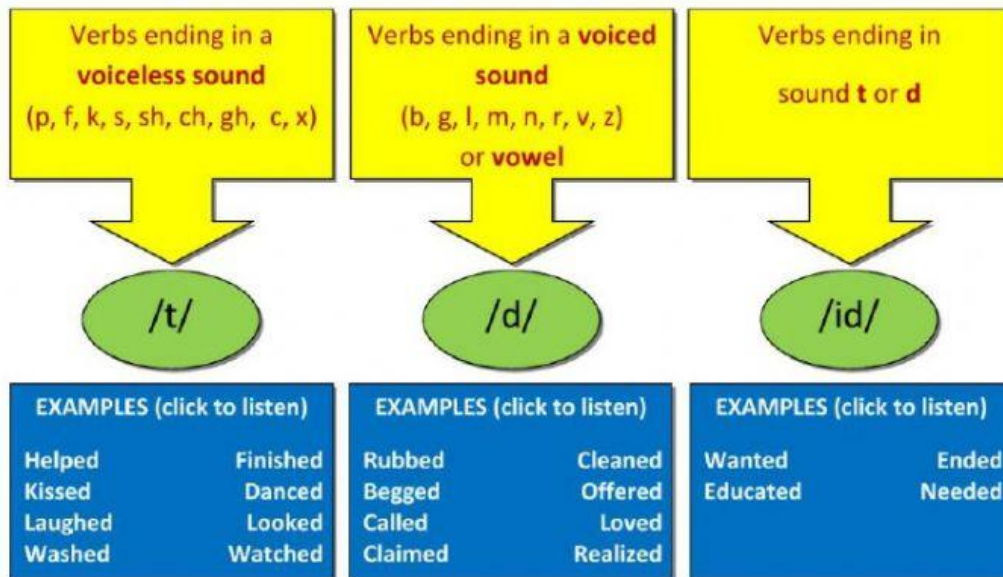


# Pronunciation of -ed

There are three ways to pronounce the final **-ed** of regular verbs in the simple past. This pronunciation depends on the **final sound** of the verb in the **base form**: Is it a voiced consonant, an unvoiced consonant, or a vowel sound?
