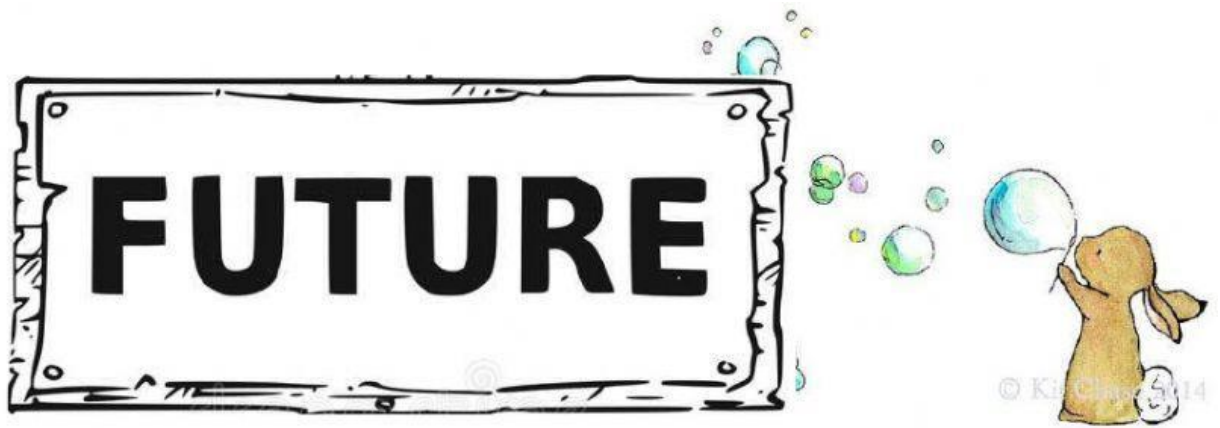




Existen dos tipos de futuros, el planeado o de intención y el simple.

FUTURO PLANEADO o de intención:

AFIRMATIVE

Sujeto + going to + verbo

"I am going to work"

NEGATIVE

Sujeto + not + going to + verbo

"I am not going to work."

INTERROGATIVE

Sujeto (invertido) + going to + verbo

"Am I going to work?"

Se usa, como indica su nombre, para un futuro planeado. Es decir, para algo que sabemos que pasará porque así lo hemos decidido.

"El próximo verano iré de vacaciones"

También se usa para cosas que vemos que van a pasar.

"Hoy va a llover"



FUTURO SIMPLE:

AFIRMATIVE

Sujeto + will + verbo

"She will work"

NEGATIVE

Sujeto + will + not + verbo

"She won't work" (will not= won't)

INTERROGATIVE

Will + sujeto + verbo

"Will she go to EuroDisney"

Se usa para tomar decisiones instantáneas.

"I left the door open,
I will close it right now"

Para opiniones personales,
que empiezan por "I think",
"I hope" o "I sure"

Para hacer un ofrecimiento,
promesa o una predicción
(inventada)

"I will help you" (ofrecimiento)

"I will love you forever" (promesa)

"You will be rich" (predicción)
