Dạng câu hỏi gián tiếp là dạng 'Câu hỏi thông thường + từ nghi vấn' nên điều quan trọng nhất phải tập trung lắng nghe từ nghi vấn đi sau câu hỏi thông thường.

Chiến lược làm bài

- ❖ Bạn hãy chú ý nghe từ nghi vấn, chìa khóa cho câu hỏi gián tiếp.
- ❖ Đáp án trả lời cho câu hỏi có từ nghi vấn ở sau là đáp án đúng.
- ❖ Cách trả lời tương tự với cách trả lời câu hỏi thông tin (WHO/ WHOM/ WHERE/ WHEN/ WHY/ WHAT/ HOW) nhưng có thể bắt đầu với "Yes" hoặc "No".

Những dạng hỏi đáp thường gặp

- Q. Do you know why Rebecca went home so early?** Bạn có biết vì sao Rebecca lại về nhà sớm không
→ **I think she had some emergency.** Tôi nghĩ cô ấy có việc gấp.
- Q. Do you know when they are coming?** Bạn có biết khi nào họ sẽ tới không?
→ **I haven't heard.** Tôi chưa nghe nói.
- Q. Can you tell me where the bakery is?** Bạn có thể cho tôi biết tiệm bánh mì ở đâu không?
→ **There's one on the next corner.** Có một tiệm ở đoạn rẽ tiếp theo.
- Q. Do you know who was selected as a speaker?** Bạn có biết ai đang được chọn diễn thuyết không?
→ **No, I have no idea.** Không, tôi không biết.

Q. Do you know where Dr. Patel's dental office is?

- (A) He's a software developer.
(B) I just saw a doctor.
(C) On the tenth floor.

Giải thích: Với câu hỏi gián tiếp có từ nghi vấn xuất hiện ở giữa, chỉ cần nghe được từ nghi vấn thôi thì bạn cũng có thể dễ dàng giải quyết được đề bài nhưng trái lại nếu không nghe được bạn sẽ khó mà tìm ra đáp án đúng. Nếu nhớ được rằng câu nghi vấn *Where* đáp án dạng 'in+[at/on]+địa điểm' thường luôn là đáp án đúng thì bạn sẽ biết ngay đáp án đúng là (C). Đáp án (A) sử dụng *software* có phát âm tương tự *where* của câu hỏi để gây nhiễu. (B) cũng lặp lại từ *doctor* của câu hỏi để gây nhiễu.
