Set up: **To place or to build** something

DEAL WITH

To handle, take care of (problem, situation)

▶ Lisa is not good at dealing with stress.



Give up = to quit; to stop doing something

To stop doing something, especially something that used to be a habit.

To stop consuming (eating, drinking, etc.) something because it is not good for your health.

✓ You should **give up** smoking because not only is it bad for your health, but it also makes you look ugly.



Give up = to surrender; to stop trying

You abandon your attempt to do something when you realize that there may be no way of completing it successfully. To stop making an effort.

✓ He **gave up** after realizing that he couldn't win the game.

✓ I **give up** - can you please tell me the answer?

Give away

Meaning: Make a gift of (something)

E.g. I didn't like that book, so I **gave it away**.

= to search for (someone/something)

(Transitive)

This phrasal verb is used when a person is searching for or trying to find someone or something. You often **look for** something when you have lost it, need it or want it.

This phrasal verb is frequently used in a progressive tense.



Look for + person/thing

I'm **looking for** my keys. ✓
I'm **looking for** them. ✓
I'm **looking** **my** **keys** **for**. ✗
