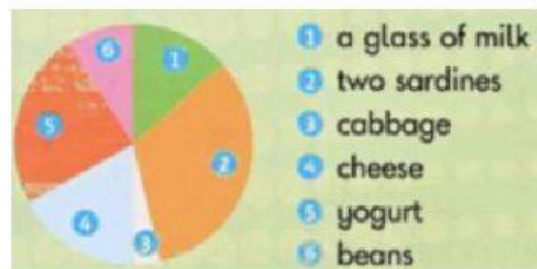
Eat a healthy diet
