ACTIVITY 1: Study this Information.

Esta tabla explica como se forma el tiempo futuro. Como se observa, el verbo auxiliar es “will” y el negativo es “won’t”. Sólo se coloca el auxiliar antes del verbo en infinitivo para armar la oración.

Example: She **will buy** books online = Ella comprará libros online. (will buy)

She **won’t buy** books online = Ella no comprará libros online. (won’t buy)

Personal pronoun	Auxiliary verb	Infinitive verb	Complement
<i>She</i>	<i>will / won’t</i>	<i>buy</i>	<i>books online</i>

Future (will + infinitive)

We use **will** + infinitive without *to* to talk about plans for the future. (Something we think, believe or know will happen.)

The new security system **will protect** our customer's better.

Hackers **won't/will not get** into the network.

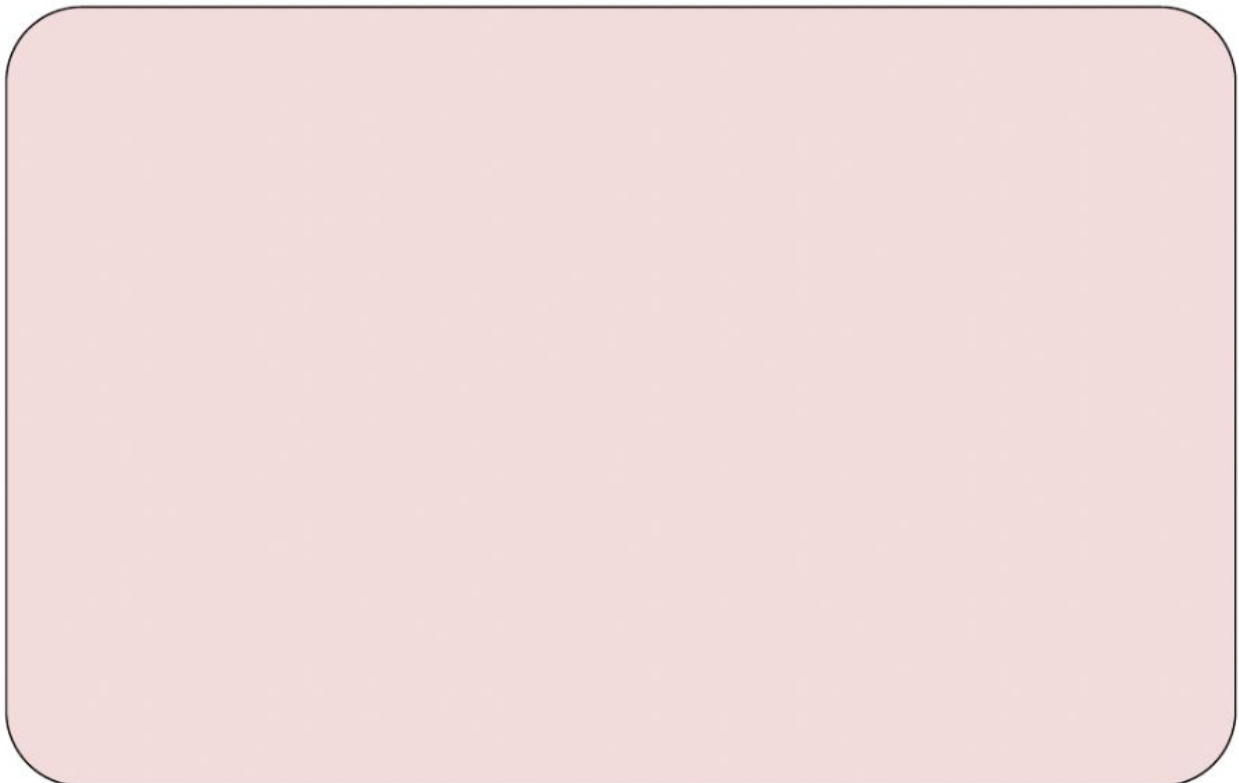
When **will** we **change** to the new security system?
