

## Like + -ing questions and short answers



### Questions

Do I like playing?  
Do you like playing?  
Does he like playing?  
Does she like playing?  
Does it like playing?  
Do we like playing?  
Do you like playing?  
Do they like playing?

### Short answers

Yes, I **do**.  
Yes, you **do**.  
Yes, he **does**.  
Yes, she **does**.  
Yes, it **does**.  
Yes, we **do**.  
Yes, you **do**.  
Yes, they **do**.  
No, I **don't**.  
No, you **don't**.  
No, he **doesn't**.  
No, she **doesn't**.  
No, it **doesn't**.  
No, we **don't**.  
No, you **don't**.  
No, they **don't**.

Note that we don't repeat the **-ing** verb in short answers.

Jamie, do you like reading? No, I **don't**.

Does Polly like cooking? Yes, she **does**.
