When Aimee Mullins was born on 20th July 1975, there was a problem with her feet. At the age of one, she had an operation. Doctors amputated her feet and part of her legs. Aimee was a little child then so she didn't understand how serious her problem was. Aimee spent the first ten years of her life on a wheelchair.

Life at school wasn't always easy. She was sometimes discriminated against. Sometimes she suffered because she went to a school which wasn't prepared for disabled people. For example there weren't special toilets and it was very difficult for her to go to her classroom on the second floor because there wasn't a lift. Luckily, she had many friends who helped her climb up and down the stairs everyday.

But Aimee's life suddenly changed at the age of 11, after a second operation. Doctors decided to give her artificial legs. Quickly she learnt to swim and run. She even learnt to play football. Suddenly, going to her classroom wasn't a problem anymore, and she could do everything she wanted. She never used her wheelchair again.

Now Aimee has a beautiful family. Her husband is a teacher and they have got two children. Aimee spends most of her time with her family. She has a totally normal life: she cleans the house, goes to the shops and drives!
