



Like + -ing

- We use like + -ing form of the ver. If the ver ends in consonant + -e, we drop the final e (e.g.: live - living).
- If a short verb ends in consonant + vowel + consonant, we double the final consonant before adding -ing (e.g. swim - swimming).
- For verbs with two or more syllables, we do not usually double the final consonant (e.g. listen - listening)
