

Future Time Clauses

Until, After, Before, As soon as, When, If

Combine the sentences with the words in brackets as in the example.

1. First Peter will go home. Then he will have a rest. (After)

After Peter goes home, he will have a rest.

2. First Jane will have a shower. Then she will eat breakfast. (Before)

3. First I will finish the work and I will go to the party. (As soon as)

4. First the children will do their homework. Then they will play football in the garden. (until)

5. First you will give me your number. I will phone you. (If)

6. First I will have dinner. I will wash the dishes. (After)

7. First I will wash the vegetables. Then I will eat them. (Before)

8. First she will finish law school. Then she will move to London. (As soon as)

9. First I will have enough time. Then I will come to the party. (If)

10. First you will take your umbrella. Then you will go out. (Before)

11. First the bell will ring. We will go home. (As soon as)

12. First Mary will call. Then I will ask about the test. (When)

13. First she will finish the interview. Then she will leave her office. (until)

14. First she will go to the store. Then she will buy her mother's birthday present. (When)

15. First I will clean the living room. Then our guests will arrive. (Before)
