Please explain this answer to me.

### **Give something TO somebody**

I gave some flowers to my girlfriend.

### **Listen TO something / somebody**

Please listen to me!

### **Look AT something / somebody**

Oh! Look at the sky! It's beautiful.

### **Pay somebody FOR something**

I paid the waiter for the coffee.

### **Talk TO somebody ABOUT something**

She talked to her sister about her job.

### **Wait FOR something / somebody**

Could you please wait for me?

### **Worry ABOUT something**

My mother always worries about me.
