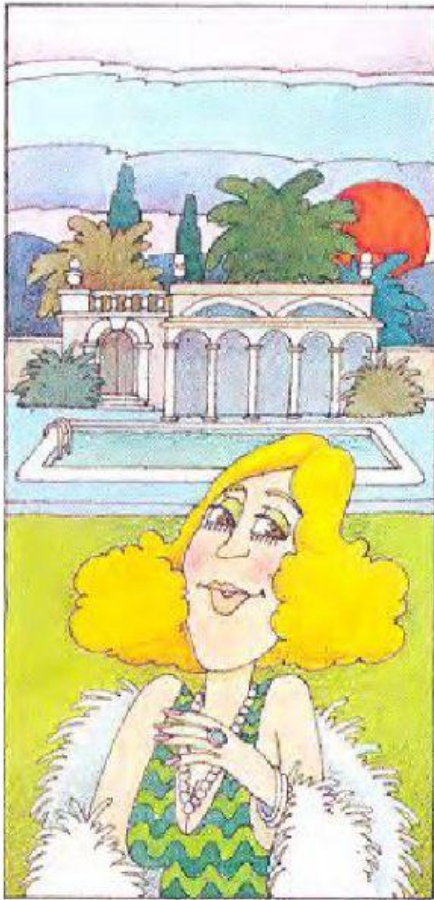


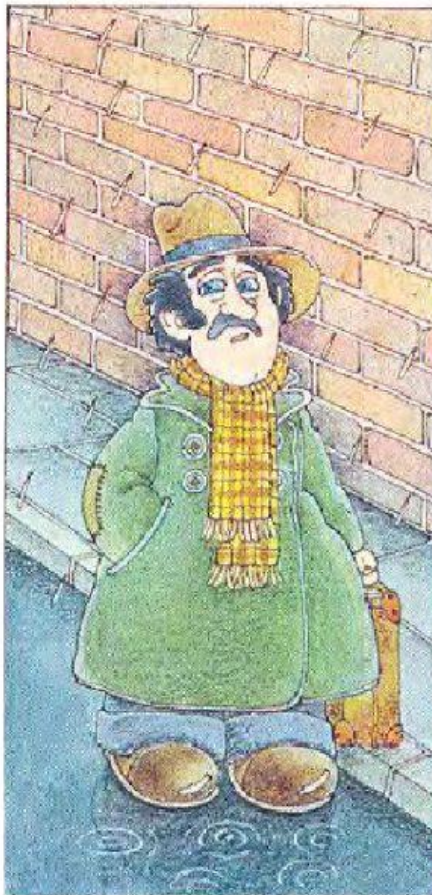
Three different worlds
