If / When + Simple Present, + Simple Present

Remember:

When we talk about a SHE / HE / IT (singular) verb + S, ES or IES.

Negative: HE/SHE/IT: DOESN'T

I/ YOU/ WE/ THEY: DON'T

VERB BE: AM / IS / ARE
