Solve 2 Step Word Problems on Addition & Subtraction

- (1) Christian had 160 dollars in his bank account. He withdrew 56 to buy fifteen books that he wanted. Then he deposited his pay check, which was for one hundred forty-seven dollars. How much did he then have in his account?

- (2) Christopher had forty socks and ten shirts in his drawer. He threw away 13 of the socks because they had holes. Then he bought a new package of twelve socks. How many socks does he have now?

- (3) Kimberly had ninety-seven songs on her phone. She deleted 59 of the ones she didn't like, and then downloaded seventy-two new songs. She then had eight gigabytes of free space. How many songs does she have on her phone now?

(4) On Halloween, Michelle collected one hundred fifteen pieces of candy, including 65 that were chocolate. She didn't like 80 pieces, so she gave them to her sister. Her sister then gave her 77 pieces of the kind she did like. How many pieces of candy did Michelle have now?

5. Kenneth had 40 socks and 14 shirts in his drawer. He threw away 11 of the socks because they had holes. Then he bought a new package of 12 socks. How many socks does he have now?

6. On Halloween, Amber collected 111 pieces of candy, including 60 that were chocolate. She didn't like 71 pieces, so she gave them to her sister. Her sister then gave her 51 pieces of the kind she did like. How many pieces of candy did Amber have now?

7. Zachary started his lawnmowing business with ninety-four dollars. He had to spend sixty-seven dollars on tools and supplies. Then, in his first month, he earned seventy-six dollars. How much money did he then have?
